Factsheet 1: sectoral driving ban in Tirol

For the compliance with the sectoral driving ban on the A 12 Inntalautobahn following ROLA trains are available.

Wörgl – Brenner v.v. from EUR 98
Wörgl – Trento v.v. from EUR 217

Shipment of car transporters which exceed the dimensions of 4m height and 19m in length are only allowed to use the ROLA trains in the Wörgl-Brenner v.v. corridor until further notice.

Which area?

from 1. November 2016

A 12, in both driving directions, km 6,35 municipal district of Langkampfen bis km 72,00 municipal district of Ampass

Which vehicles?

Lorries or tractor-trailers with a maximum gross weight exceeding 7,5 t and semi-trailer trucks where the sum of the maximum gross weight of both tractor and trailer are over 7,5 t

Which goods classes? (§ 3 Abs. 1 lit. a - h)

- All types of wastes, which are listed on the European waste catalogue (according to the decision of the commission about the waste catalogue, 2000/532/EG, in the version 2014/955/EU)
- Stones, soil, excavation
- Round timber and cork
- Motor vehicles from upper and lower groups L1e, L2e, L3e, L4e, L5e, L6e, L7e, M1, M2 and N1
- Non-ferrous and iron ores
- Steel, except reinforcing and construction steel for delivery to constructions sites
- Marble and travertine
- Tiles (ceramic)

Exceptions

- Journeys made by vehicles which are loaded or unloaded in the core zone (departure or arrival in the core zone)
- Journeys made by vehicles which are loaded or unloaded in the enlarged zone (departure or arrival in the enlarged zone)
- Journeys on the way to the railway loading in the direction to the Hall train terminal in Tirol in driving direction east as well as to train terminal Wörgl in driving directions west, if it is proved by appropriate document
- Journeys after railway transportation from railway terminal Hall in Tirol direction to the west and from railway terminal Wörgl in direction to the east, if it is proved by appropriate document
- Urgent trips of the Austrian armed forces or foreign troops on Austrian territory according to the respective regulations BGBl. I Nr. 57/2001, latest amended by regulation BGBl. I Nr. 181/2013, as well as transports for assistance made by notified aid organisations
- under 115. Regulation of the Governor from October 31, 2016, Sectoral driving ban regulations will be changed.
