Important ROLA tips

As we have already announced a few weeks ago, a change in the Sectoral Driving Ban will come into force in Tyrol on 1 January 2020.

The parking space at the ROLA terminals is limited and only intended for temporary stopping in preparation for loading onto the train.

From January 2020, our trains will run every hour.

Five important tips for your trouble-free and quick check-in to the ROLA train:

- **The truck should not arrive earlier than 1 hour before the latest check-in**
- **Prepare the booking confirmation and all documents at hand**
- **Prepare and attach safety devices such as lashing straps**
- **Prepare means of payment (see ROLA Homepage)**
- **Please follow the instructions of the terminal staff**

You will find all important information such as checklists, general conditions of carriage, safety instructions and general terms and conditions at the agency in different languages.

Please forward this information to your truck drivers so we can assure you a short stay at the terminal and a punctual departure of the train.
