Non-Smoking Protection on ROLA trains

Dear Ladies and Gentleman,

On 1st November 2019, the Non-Smoking Protection Act (TNRSG) was amended and has since banned smoking in restaurants and closed means of transport. Since the ROLA passenger cars fall under both points, we would like to point out that there is a strict smoking ban on the Rolling Road.

Non-compliance with the smoking ban is an administrative violation, which is punished with a fine of up to € 100, in the event of repetition even up to € 1,000 (§ 14, section 5).

In addition, a response to the cigarette smoke from the fire alarm system can lead to emergency braking and thus also to high oncosts. We are obliged to document each incident and forward it to the employer or client.

In order to ensure a stress-free and pleasant ROLA ride, we ask you to make your drivers aware of the non-smoking protection on the ROLA trains.
